

CURRICULUM VITAE – GEORGE SFAKIANAKIS

George Sfakianakis, Associate Professor of Economic Analysis at the Technological Education Institute of Sterea Ellada and Adjunct Faculty Member at the Hellenic Open University, was born in Athens in 1967.

He studied economics at the Athens University of Economics and Business where he obtained his doctoral degree on Economic Analysis (Endogenous Economic Growth - Ph.D. in Economics). He has worked for the Council of Economic Advisers at the Hellenic Ministry of Economy and Finance where he has also been appointed as Chairman. He has worked for the Directorate General of Economic Policy at the Hellenic Ministry of Finance, the Centre of Planning and Economic Research and the private sector.

He has represented Greece in numerous Committees abroad, including the *Economic Policy Committee (E.P.C.)*, the *Economic and Financial Committee (E.F.C.)*, the *Euro Working Group (E.W.G.)* and the *Group of National Experts for Forecasting* of the Commission of the E.U., as well as the *Economic Policy Committee (E.P.C.)*, the *Working Party 1 (WPI)* and the *Committee on Financial Markets (C.F.M.)* of the O.E.C.D. He was also the Alternate of the Minister of the Hellenic Ministry of Economy and Finance at the *Eurogroup* and the *ECOFIN* Council and Alternate Director of the I.M.F. for Greece participating in the Annual Meetings of the I.M.F. and the World Bank.

He has numerous publications in international journals of Economics and Business and has participated in many international Conferences. He is also a referee for international scientific journals. He has been a member of the Board of Directors of the Public Power Corporation (DEH S.A.), the Athens Trolley Company (HLPAP S.A.), the Public Debt Management Agency (ODDHX) and the Foundation for Economic and Industrial Research (IOBE).
